



# Fitting Instructions

We highly recommend watching our instructional film which is available on [easybind.co.uk](http://easybind.co.uk) and on CD-Rom. Easybind was invented by a group of carpet fitters in the USA in 2003. They were sick of travelling back and forwards between the job site and the carpet whipping company. This is how Easybind was born. As with all new products, it is important that on the first few installations that care is taken. Hot glue guns can drip and if care is not taken glue can get onto the carpet... if this happens, we are not responsible!



1) Prepare carpet edges.



2) When Easybind is cut the rope part will fray, so apply Sellotape around the rope and cut through the middle of the tape.



3) Always start in the middle, not a corner as it is easier to join 2 pieces on a straight section. Peel tape and press into carpet backing as you go, as shown above and right.



4) It is important to run the rope **parallel** to the carpet edge leaving sufficient gap between the carpet and the rope for the glue gun nozzle.



5) When going around a corner, cut the binding, not the rope! As shown above.
