



7) When going around an inside corner, cut the binding, not the rope! As shown above and right.



8) When joining the start and the end of the binding, apply Sellotape to the area where the cut will be made. This prevents the rope part of the binding from fraying when cut.



9) When the binding is cut, match the rope pieces together (Tip: Have the ends of the Sellotape visible to allow ease of removal). Seal the two pieces of rope with a spot of hot glue and peel the sellotape away.



10) When you are happy with the join and corners etc, use the glue gun to apply a bead of glue between the binding and the carpet backing, pinching together as you go. Be careful not to get glue on the carpet.



11) For large runs, try a piece of 2"x 2" to help attach large sections of the binding. Use a glue gun and pad to catch any glue that might drip from the end of the gun.
